

**RESOLUTION 2026 - 001**

**ESTABLISHING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE COMMITTEE AND ADOPTING PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCEDURES FOR AN UPDATE TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF YORK, WISCONSIN**

WHEREAS, §66.1001(2)(i), Wisconsin Statutes, requires that the Town of York, Wisconsin update its comprehensive plan at least once every ten years; and

WHEREAS, the Town intends to prepare and adopt an update to the Town of York Comprehensive Plan, which was adopted in 2006, under the authority of and procedures established by §66.1001(4), Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, this process requires oversight by a dedicated committee of volunteers representing Town residents; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board recommended a committee including 14 members to guide the update; and

WHEREAS, §66.1001(4)(a), Wisconsin Statutes, requires that the Town Board adopt written procedures designed to foster public participation at every stage of the plan update or amendment process, and that such written procedures provide for wide distribution of draft plan materials, an opportunity for the public to submit written comments on the plan materials, and a process for the Board to respond; and

WHEREAS, meaningful public involvement in processes to update the Town Comprehensive Plan is important to bring together diverse stakeholders to capture the shared vision for our community; and

WHEREAS, the attached "Public Participation Plan: Town of York Comprehensive Plan Update" includes procedures to foster public participation, ensure distribution of draft plan materials, provide opportunities for written comments, and provide mechanisms to respond to such comments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the York Town Board hereby establishes the Comprehensive Plan Update Committee and authorizes that Committee under §66.1001 (4)(b) to prepare an update to the Town of York Comprehensive Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Board of York, Wisconsin hereby adopts the procedures included in the "Public Participation Plan: Town of York Comprehensive Plan Update" as its public participation procedures for its update to the 2006 Comprehensive Plan, meeting the requirements of §66.1001(4)(a), Wisconsin Statutes.
