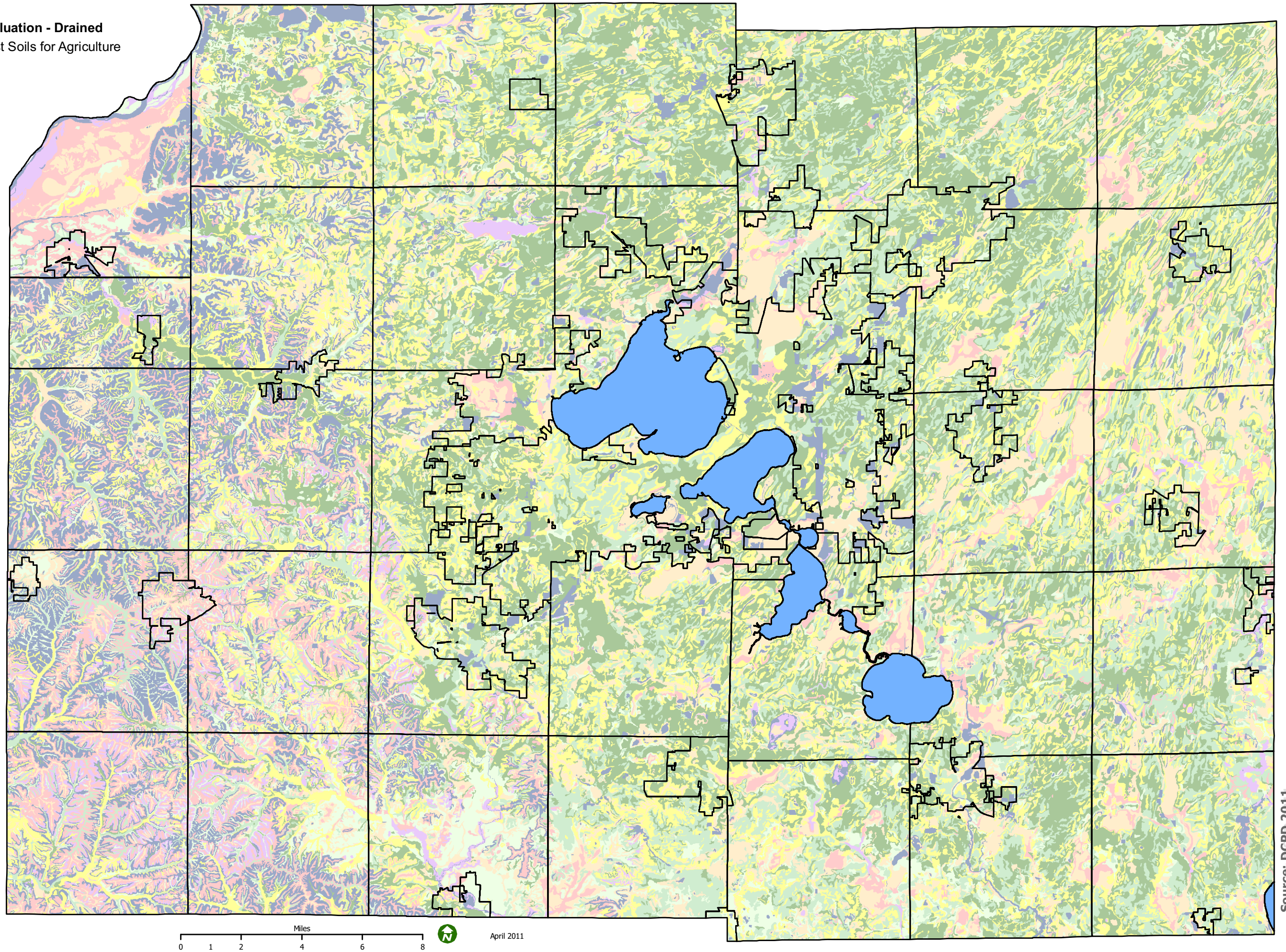
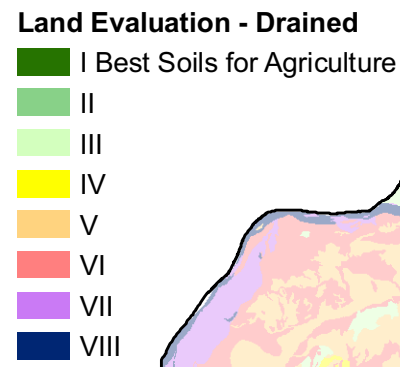


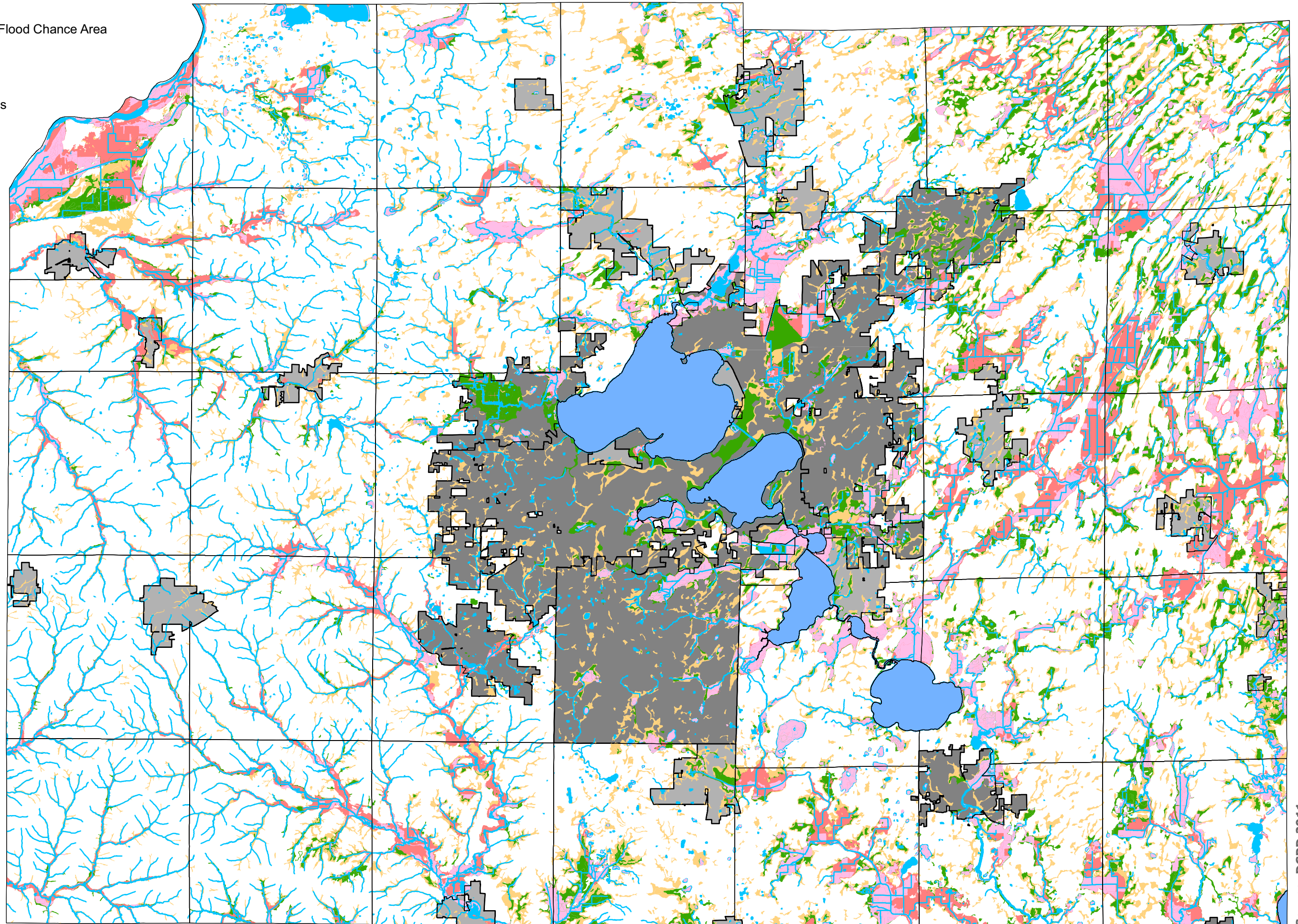
Land Evaluation - Drained Dane County, WI

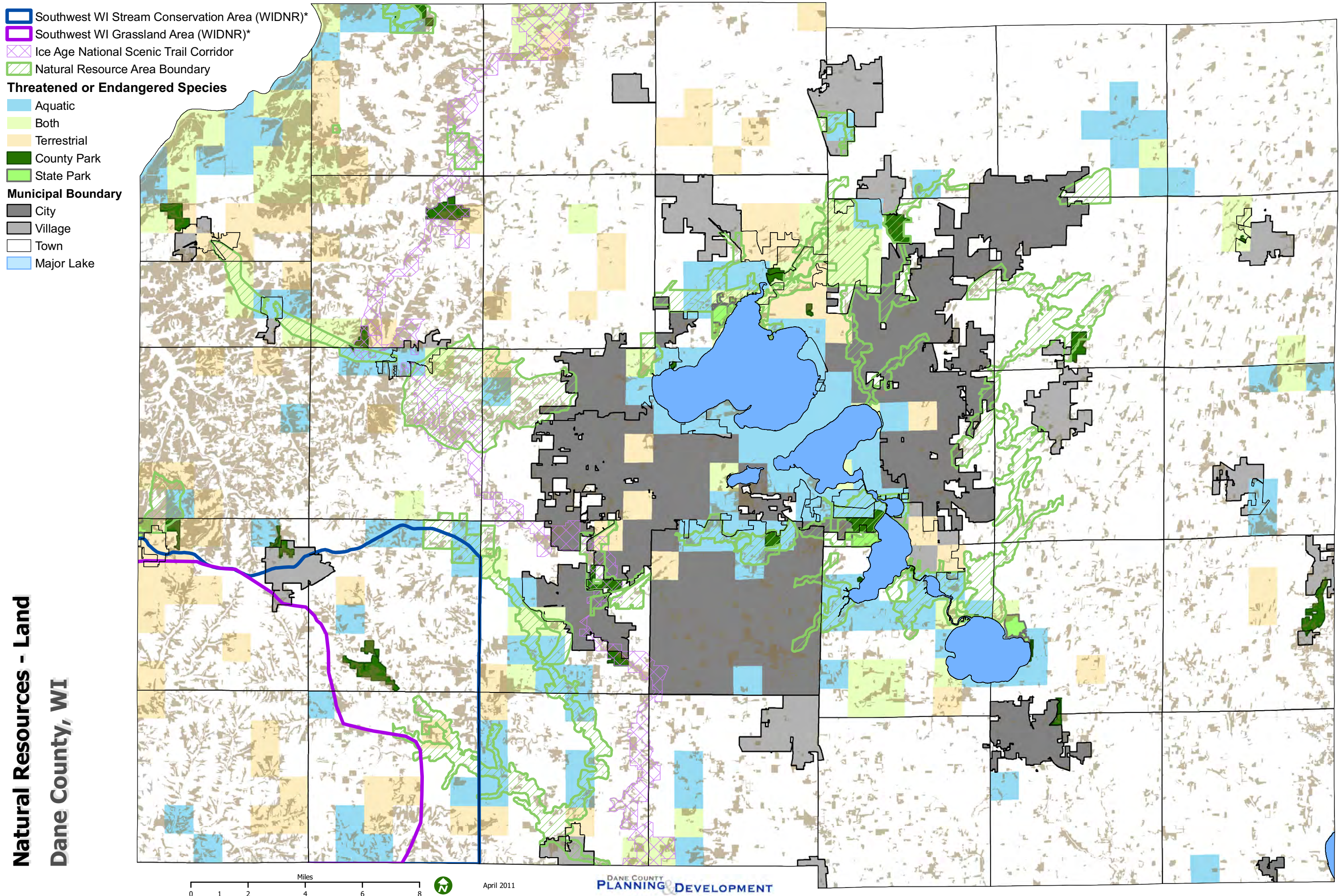
Municipal Boundary Changes 1980-2011

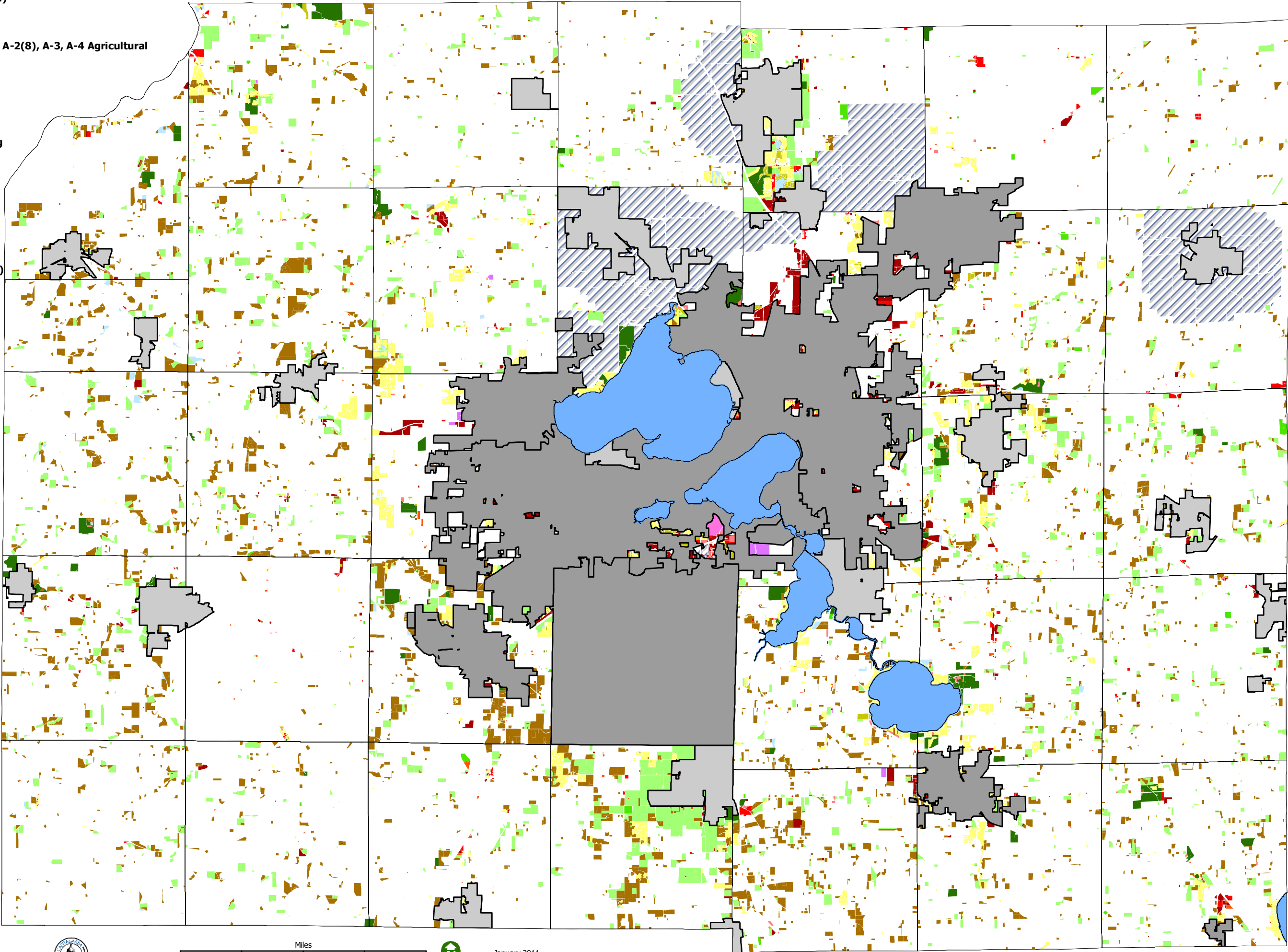

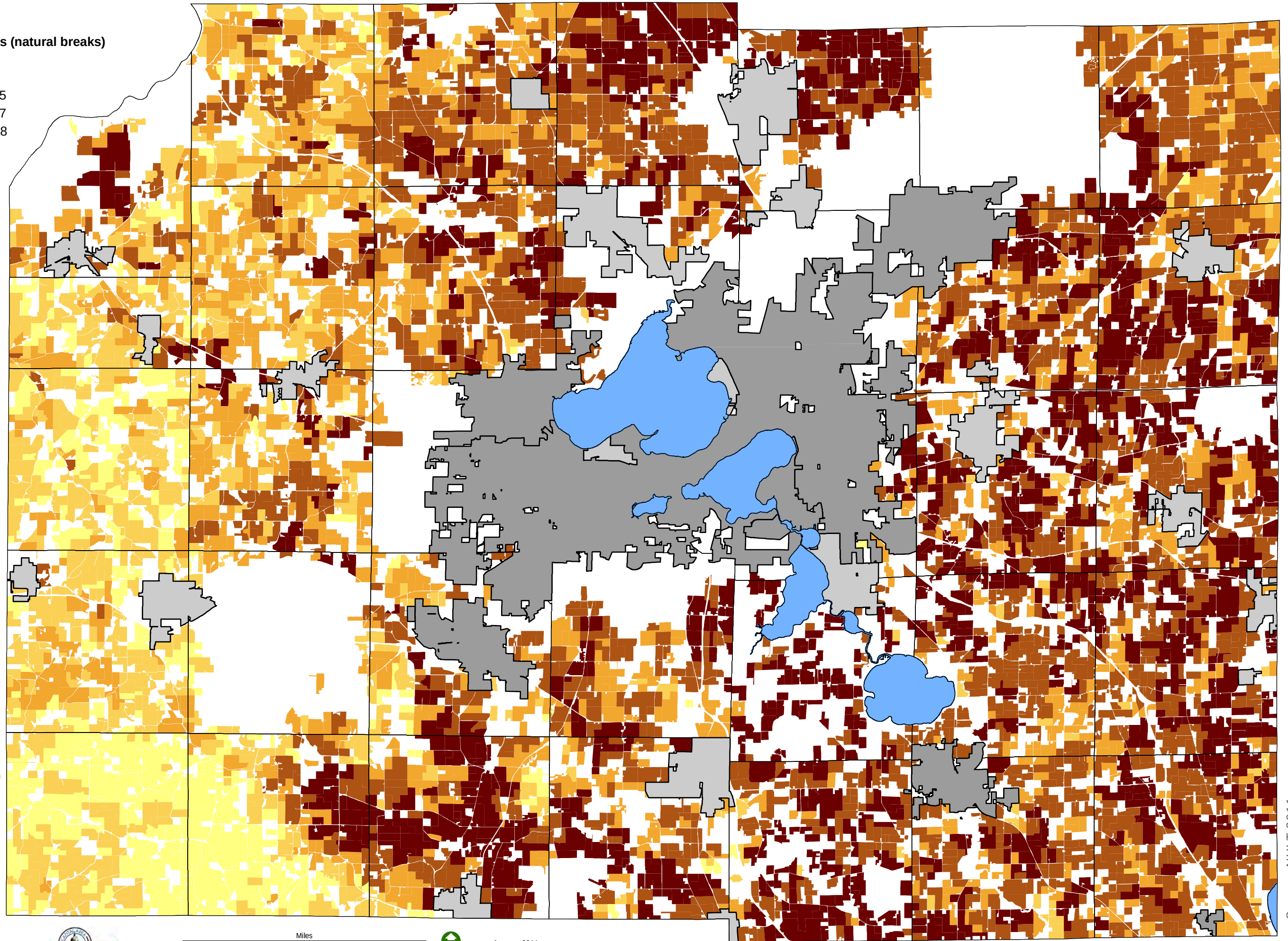
